Learning focus

The nursery learning focus has been persistence, working on overcoming challenges such as learning to stand, through art experiences, and building and climbing activities. They are now looking at coping with change with our new teacher Katey joining us and some older nursery children making visits to the preschool.





In the preschool the focus has been caring for themselves, others and the environment. The children have been learning about healthy food choices, including choosing and making healthy fruit smoothies and pizza. Sport Otago's Jump Rope weekly activity has been beneficial for looking after children's physical health. New planting has occurred in the garden beds and fairy and dinosaur gardens have been created. The preschool are also now focusing on coping with change as this is an important skill to build resilience.

Update on sustainability
