Learning focus

Over the last month we have been watching our caterpillars go through their life cycle turning into monarch butterflies with great interest.

Nursery – This month looking at coping with change as we welcome our new teachers and settle some new children into the nursery and some transitioning into the preschool. A major focus is relationships.

Preschool – Focusing on independence and self help. With our latest 5 year olds off to school, we are supporting children to be independent by finding their own sunhat and hanging up their things. At lunch children being independent with their lunchboxes, when wet learning to change clothes. Assisting with the care of the environment eg sweeping, cleaning, and gardening.

Please encourage your child to be independent when arriving such as putting their lunch box away.

Hats and clothing

Please bring a sunhat and spare clothing daily

along with a 'wet bag' to put any wet or dirty clothing in. This could be a swim bag, plastic bag or anything that is waterproof to separate this clothing from wetting other items in your child's backpack. We will no longer be providing plastic bags for this purpose.

We are trailing having bare feet in the preschool while we have warmer weather due to feedback from parents. Please name your children's shoes and socks and send them in shoes they can manage (ie velcro rather than laces) to support their growing independence.

Car parking

If you arrive or pick up your child during a peak time (such as 9-9.30am), please try to make this transition quickly as other parents are waiting for the 10 minute park.

Also please avoid parking in the staff driveway when possible as teachers have been waiting long periods to start their shifts recently unable to park their car in the drive.
